Terms : Dynamics

fortissimo (**ff**) forte (**f**) mezzo forte (*mf*) pianissimo (**pp**) piano (**p**) mezzo piano (*mp*) crescendo (cresc.) decrescendo (decresc.) diminuendo (dim)

very Loud (-issimo means 'very') loud moderately loud very quite quiet moderately quiet gradually getting louder gradually getting quieter gradually getting quieter

Terms : Tempo

allegro allegretto moderato andante adagio accelerando (accel.) rallentando (rall.) ritardando(ritard. or rit.) a tempo

quick fairly quick at a moderate speed at a medium speed slow gradually getting quicker gradually getting slower gradually getting slower in time (resume the original speed)

More Terms

cantabile da capo (D.C) dolce fine legato staccato (stacc.) in a singing style repeat from the beginning sweet the end (*al fine = 'up to the end'*) smoothly detached

Signs



= 80

Fermata - pause on the note or rest Metronome mark: Play at a tempo of 80 crotchet beats per minute

Accent the note - play with emphasis

Gradually getting louder (crescendo)

> Gradually getting quieter (diminuendo)



slur - perform smoothly



tie - hold for the value of the two notes.
